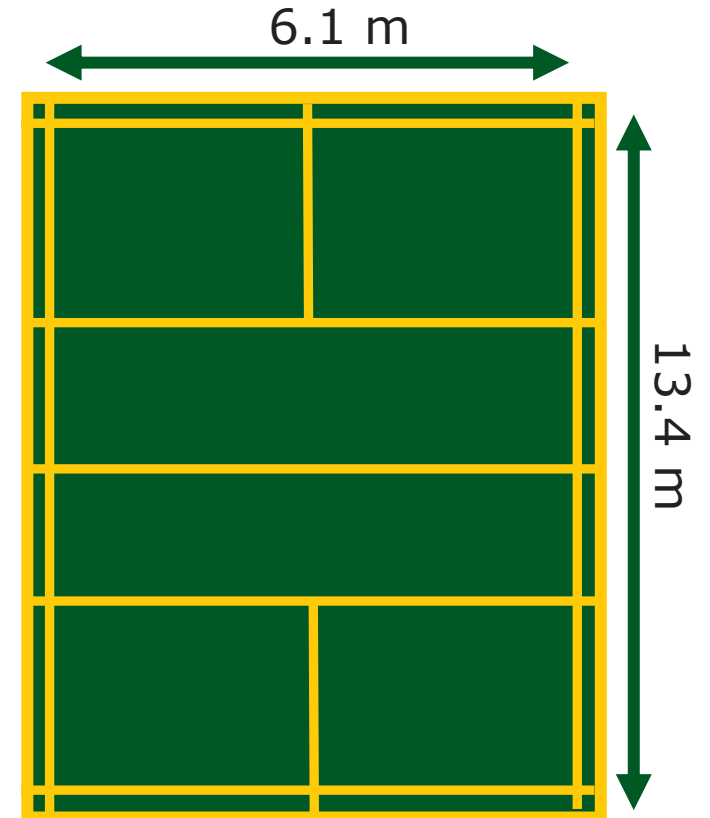

Space: 1 vs 1. Played on a Badminton Court (6.1m - 13.4m).

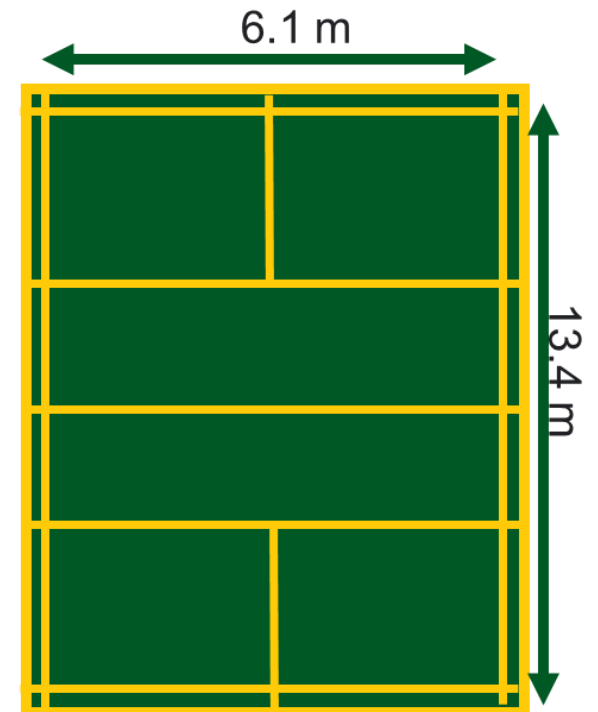
Task: One set to 21 points (2 points clear: E.g. 22-24) or 10 minute timed game.

Equipment: Badminton Net, 2x rackets, 1x shuttlecock. Correct badminton court markings.

People: 1 vs 1.

Rules

- Serving changes every 2 points.
- Serving must be diagonal.
- Rally is over when the shuttlecock touches the floor, goes out of bounds, or does not go over the net.

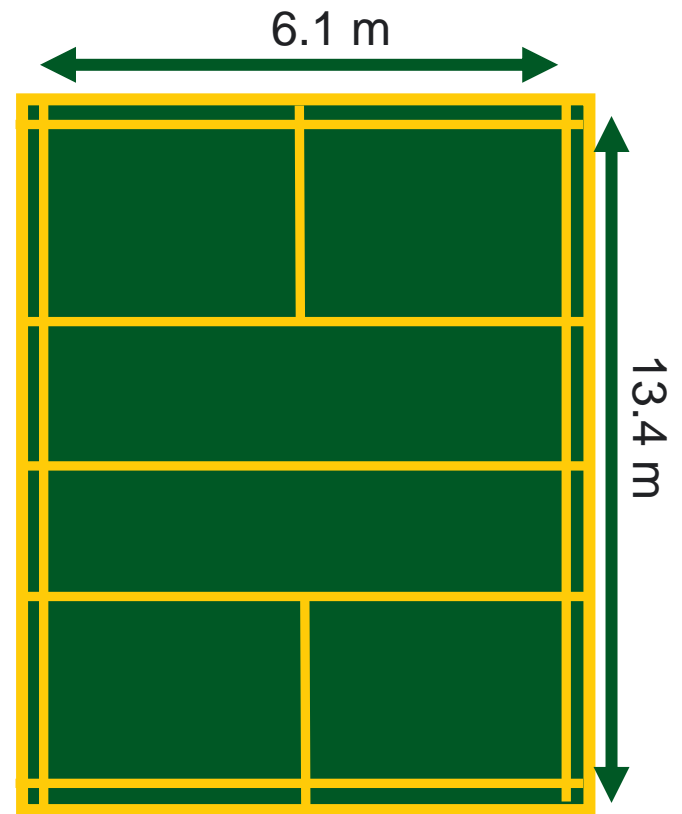
One set to 21 points (2 points clear

court (13.4 x 6.1).



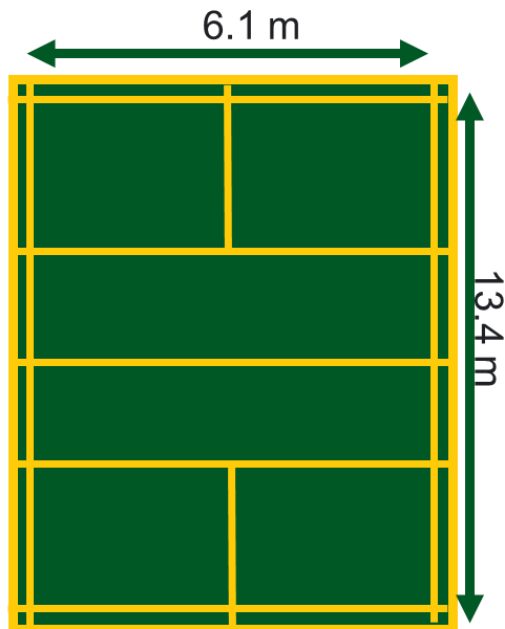
Badminton Doubles

Space: 2 vs 2. Played on a Badminton Court.

Task: One set to 21 points (2 points clear E.g: 22-24) or 10 minute timed game

Rules

- Serving changes every 2 points.
- Serving must be diagonal.
- Rally is over when the shuttlecock touches the floor, goes out of bounds, or does not go over the net.



Equipment:

An alternative competition format for Leicestershire Intra School Badminton

Years 7, 8, 9, 10 & 11 Girls and Boys competitions

Format to be used to run an Intra School year group Badminton Competition

(In the absence of, or to run alongside Inter schools competition)

Examples of simple doubles competitions for one year group.

1. Starting with the very minimum of 4 pairs taking part in separate girls' and boys' competitions (Eg: 1 pair of boys and 1 pair of girls from each house). Play a round robin competition (as suggested below) with the 4 pairs, which is 6 games, to determine a winning pair. If played to 21 points the approximate time to play the round robin would be 1hr (estimated time is 10mins per game) if played on 1 court.

2. If there are more participating pairs (say a maximum of 4 from each house, and therefore 16 pairs in total using 4 courts) the **RED** format above would be applied (replicated on each of the 4 courts) and completed in approx 1hr. To determine the top overall year group pair, you would need to extend the time by 20-30mins and take the top pair from each of the 4 groups to play a semi-final followed by a final.
3. In either of the above scenarios, if there is a time restriction, you could reduce the points per game, say to either 11 or 15.
4. **Please Note:** Singles can also be played using the same formats as above.
5. It is understood that some schools give house points - each school would decide how this would be done.
